Remark about the playing field used for the provincial finals: The track floor will be grey rather than black and the tape delimiting the track will be a contrasting colour.

99- After reading Rule 4.17, my understanding is that to recharge the vehicle once per lap, my vehicle would have to stop and would thus only complete one lap? And what if the vehicle's wheels were to continue moving during the recharging operation?

Indeed, stopping the vehicle after one lap is not a winning solution since your turn would be considered over. However, if the wheels continue to turn and the vehicle is moving, then it's okay.

Q100- I read in the FAQ that a vehicle cannot be operated by remote control because the vehicle has to be autonomous; but could an electrical system mounted on the base be remote controlled, without affecting the vehicle's autonomy?

that specific time, does the device have to be in the box?
